Site incompatible with the community: The garbage dump site is in Section 30, a square mile with several mined-out gravel pits, and is surrounded by Clark County residents. The site is within 1/4 mile of Shahala Middle School, Illahee Elementary school, Glad Tidings Church, and several housing developments. Approval Would Be Costly to Taxpayers: The garbage dump plan was deemed inadequate by the Hearings Examiner. Provisions for safety of the water table, the environment and adjacent land are vague, inadequate and non-existent. There are 84 conditions imposed by the Hearings Examiner, in the event of approval, creating an eventual burden upon taxpayers.

Taxpayers would pay for the 50-year attempt to enforce these 84 conditions, requiring more government employees, more technical resources and more taxpayer \$\$\$!

Alternative uses would provide tax revenue and enhance the value of additional 500+ acres in Section 30: Evergreen School Dist., Clark College and others would like to locate campuses, open space and sports facilities in Sec. 30, but not beside a garbage dump! A shopping complex is planned for S.E. First Street and 192nd Ave., and mixed-use and light industrial plans are being considered by members of the Sec. 30 Subarea Planning Committee, the J.D. White Co. and Otak. Far-sighted, innovative ideas will emerge from this planning for a clean, safe community. Meetings are open to the public. A Sec. 30 Subarea Planning Open house will be Wed., August 27, from 6 to 8:00 P.M., at the Illahee School Gym, 192nd and First St. The next Sec. 30 Subarea Committee meeting is Sept. 15, from 6 to 8:00 p.m. at Camas Fire Station #42.
